- Helping with callout database management, data analysis etc.
- Drafting content for social media from key incidents, collating photos and videos.
- Managing BDMLR social media groups.

- Previous experience in animal rescue or a related field preferred but not essential, full training will be provided.
- Exceptional communication skills, with the ability to empathise and remain calm in stressful situations.
- Strong organisational skills with the ability to multitask and prioritise effectively, including time management.
- Knowledge of animal behaviour, basic medical care, and rescue techniques.
- Familiarity with national animal welfare regulations.
